



## **UNIFORM POLICY**

### **BNW CHAMPIONSHIPS & PENNANT COMPETITIONS**

- The Bowls Australia Logo Policy as amended from time to time will apply to all persons playing in BNW Championships and BNW Pennant competitions.
- All persons playing in BNW Pennant competitions must wear their own approved Club's uniform.
- Players from a club making up a composite BNW Pennant side may wear approved attire as if they were a side in their own right.
- It is up to individual Clubs to determine what their Club uniform is (which must be approved by BNW) and what, how and when it should be worn (provided that it complies with the Bowls Australia and BNW policies).
- In approving Club uniforms, BNW is only interested in Club lower body wear and polo tops.
- Outerwear worn by players should be in Club colours.

### **BNW REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS**

#### **PLAYERS**

- Players chosen to represent BNW (men and ladies) will be supplied with one (1) complete uniform consisting of shirt, pants or shorts, cap and jacket.
- Uniforms will be on loan to players and must be returned to the respective Team Manager following the completion of competition.
- Any additional garments requested by the players are at the players own cost.

#### **OFFICIALS**

- All officials will be provided with a complete uniform on a loan basis only and must be returned to BNW at the completion of the event.
- If officials require alterations to these garments then they must be purchased.

## **LOAN PROCESS**

- All loan items will be numbered.
- Players/Officials must sign a loan form indicating the numbered garment they have borrowed.
- The player/official will be responsible for loss or damage to the garments on loan to them and will be issued with an account if not returned in an appropriate state deemed by BNW.
- Uniforms must be returned to either the respective Team Manager or BNW within seven days of the completion of scheduled play.
- It is strongly recommended where possible that loan uniforms are returned to the Team Manager at the completion of competition and appropriate paperwork completed at that time.

- BNW will be responsible for all laundering of uniforms once returned after use.
